LANDFALL FOUNDATION AWARDS 54 GRANTS TOTALING \$216,731

WILMINGTON, NC—The Landfall Foundation today (Nov. 4, 2010) presented checks to 54 agencies to fund projects in the greater Wilmington area totaling \$216,731. Due to a significant increase in fund raising this past year, foundation grants for 2010 are up \$80,424 more this year than last year's awards of \$136,307 to 41 agencies. The current grants bring to \$2,037,000 funds contributed to local non-profits and scholarship recipients since the foundation was established.

"Despite the slow recovery of the economy, the community of Landfall and Foundation supporters within the Wilmington area contributed a record amount for giving this year," said Landfall Foundation Acting President Shirley Heusel. "Between our increased sponsorships for the gala, our returning participants for the races and Art Show and our newest Friends, as a group we have demonstrated we are truly Together in Community Giving. 2009 saw an increase in the numbers of people needing services. 2010 grant applications made it clear that needs had not diminished, and in some areas, had greatly increased."

Through the generosity of the residents of the Landfall community, the foundation has provided meaningful assistance to non-profit organizations in the categories of health and welfare, education and the arts since 1996. Co-chairs of the 2010 Grants Committee were Landfall residents David Ellis and Barb Biehner.
