The generosity of Landfall residents is vital to the success of our program which has been in existence for over 16 years. On behalf of the foundation, and the scholarship recipients, we would like to thank our contributors for their continued support of the foundation and its mission.

To qualify for a scholarship, the student employee must work 15 hours per week over the course of the semester for which the funds are sought and have maintained at least a 2.5 GPA for that particular semester. Each is eligible for a 20 percent reimbursement during their first year of employment, with a reimbursement rate that caps at 50 percent during the fourth year.
